DAY VISIT TO BLETCHLEY PARK Wednesday 10 September 2025 Arriving at 11.00am and leaving at 4.30pm

An early start to facilitate the time needed to explore this once top-secret home of the WWII Codebreakers, now a vibrant heritage attraction, set within the beautifully restored historic buildings of Bletchley Park. The faithfully recreated WWII rooms guide you on a journey into the past; see the museum's collections, watch immersive films, and get involved in the interactive displays, which tell the story of the once top-secret operations, the brilliant minds, and complex machines that made this vital work possible, and discover the global impact Bletchley Park had on the outcome of WWII.

On arrival we will have tea/coffee, then members can explore in their own time a free flow visit or, if there is space, there is an option to join a guided tour. There are two cafes on site, spacious grounds to explore and of course a retail experience not to be missed...

THE HISTORY & VINTAGE RAILWAYS OF THE ISLE OF MAN

Departing 27th April 2026 for five days from £1,219 (Valid passport/suitable ID required)

We meet at Bristol Airport for our direct flight to the Isle of Man. On arrival we are met by a Blue Badge guide and transfer by coach to Douglas. On arrival we visit the Manx Museum. We then continue to the 3* Ramsey Park Hotel, Ramsey, where we stay for four nights on a half board basis.

Other visits during our stay include the Manx Electric Railway, the Great Laxey Wheel, Snaefell Mountain Railway, Peel Castle and Cathedral, the House of Manannan, Cregneash Village Folk Museum, Castletown, Castle Rushen, horse drawn tramway and steam train excursions, and Tynwald (the Isle of Man Parliament).

Note: Where entry is not included, those with National Trust or English Heritage membership can get in free.
